

ROAD TRAFFIC DEBTS

Fees and charges for this type of debt are based on The Enforcement of Road Traffic Debts (Certificated Bailiffs) Regulations. Schedule 1 – Table of Fees Charges & Expenses

First letter fee: £11.20

Levy Fee: - **Where the sum demanded and due does not exceed £100.00**

Charge: £28.00 + VAT

- **Where the sum demanded and due exceeds £100.00**

Charge: 28% on the first (1st) £200.00
5.5% on any additional sum over £200.00

Taking Possession Charge:

Walking Possession 55p per day for the first (1st) fourteen (14) days, 5p per day thereafter

Close Possession £5.60 per day

Attendance Charge: Up to £165.00

Removal of small vehicle (up to 35 Cwt van) Up to £165.00

Removal of large/heavy goods vehicle Up to £195.00

Cancellation of Tow Truck Up to £110.00 (where called out but not used)

To immobilise and release a vehicle: No charge

Storage at the auctioneers premises: As per the contractor's/auctioneers charging scales.

Sale at the auctioneer's premises: - 15% of the sum realised to cover the auctioneer's commission and out of pocket expenses and the reasonable costs of advertising, removal and storage.

Sale at the debtor's premises: - 7.5% of the sum realised to cover the auctioneers commission and out of pocket expenses actually and reasonably incurred.

For appraising (valuing) goods: - The reasonable fees, charges, and expenses of the broker.

Note: An appraisal (valuation) shall take place only on the written request of the debtor.

Debit or Credit Card: A small administration charge will be applicable and communicated to you prior to the payment being taken.

Please remember ignoring a debt does not make it go away and does not stop fees and charges increasing, you can only halt the process by contacting us and making an arrangement to pay.
